ARE YOU ELIGIBLE?

MUST BE A BERGEN COUNTY RESIDENT

- ◆ Suspected or confirmed clients who have active disease, regardless of the site of disease.
- ◆ Contacts to cases of clinically active TB.
- ◆ Immigrants or refugees with abnormal radiographic examination.
- ◆ Students with positive results on TB tests and tested under the NJ school mandated guidelines.
